Common names: Timothy, Herd's Grass, Cat's Tail

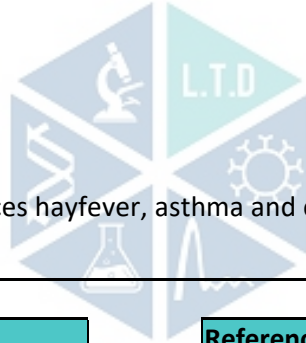
